REGULATION

1. WHERE AND WHEN

1.1 The 61st International Voci Verdiane Competition, City of Busseto, will take place in Busseto, at the Teatro Verdi, from **December 10 to 14, 2025**.

1.2 The Competition is divided into two phases:

Preliminary Phase (Art. 3);

Competition Phase consisting of three sessions:

Elimination Round, Semi-final Round and Final Concert (Art. 4).

2. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Age

The Competition is open to candidates who within December 31 2025 are between the ages of **18 and 35 years, for soprano, tenor, mezzo-soprano, contralto, baritone and bass voices**.

Non-discrimination

This Competition is aimed at both sexes, pursuant to laws 903/77 and 125/91, and to people of all nationalities, pursuant to legislative decrees 215/03 and 216/03.

Accessibility

The Competition guarantees full accessibility also to candidates with physical, sensorial and/or cognitive disabilities, who are invited to indicate their specific needs in the registration form, in the section dedicated to Accessibility. Candidates with a 100% degree of disability (presenting an appropriate certification) will be entitled to a 50% reduction on the registration fee.

3. PRELIMINARY PHASE

3.1 A Selection commission will evaluate registered candidates on the basis of the presented audiovisual material and documentation submitted.

The Committee will be jointly appointed by the Municipality of Busseto and the Fondazione Teatro Regio after the registration deadline.

At the Committee's sole discretion, a **maximum of 50 candidates** will be admitted to the next phase to be held in Busseto.

3.2 Each candidate must participate to the Competition by submitting **2 audio-video recordings**, each containing 1 opera aria with recitatives and cabalettas, where applicable.

The recordings must meet the following requirements:

- **At least one of the two arias must be composed by Giuseppe Verdi;**
- The total duration of the two recordings must not exceed **15 minutes**;
- Accompaniment must be performed live, with piano or orchestra (recordings on pre-recorded backing tracks will not be accepted);
- The candidate must be filmed from the front side, clearly showing their entire figure;
- The 2 audio-video files must be submitted in **mp4 format** and must include the candidate's full name in the file.

3.3 Applications for the Preliminary Phase of the Competition will be admitted from **September 1st until October 13th (by 11:59 p.m. UTC+1 of October 13th)**.

3.4 Registration for the Preliminary Phase of the Competition requires a **registration fee of € 50** to be paid by bank transfer within the moment of the application submission. Any possible bank commission fees are the candidate's responsibility.

This fee will only be refunded in the event of cancellation of the Competition (Art. 9).

3.5 Applications to the Preliminary Phase must be done by creating a personal profile via the links on teatroregioparma.it and vociverdiane.com.

In order to be admissible, the profile must include:

- **The candidates' personal data;**
- A copy of a **valid identity document** (identity card or passport);
- **Personal contact** details (e-mail, phone number);
- **Biography or artistic resume in Italian or English within 2000 characters including spaces;**
- **2 audio-video recordings of opera arias in mp4 format, as specified in the previous Art. 3.2, indicating the title and composer of the pieces;**
- **2 recent photos, one portrait and one full-body;**
- Proof of payment of the € 50 registration fee;
- Any specific need in the section dedicated to Accessibility (art. 2);
- Name and surname of any pianist (chosen and reimbursed by the candidate) who will accompany the candidate during any Competition.

3.6 Incomplete or late applications will not be taken into consideration.

The Competition Secretariat is not responsible for technical or other issues that may prevent timely submission.

4. COMPETITION PHASE

A maximum of 50 candidates will be admitted to the competition phase, including the first 5 classified in the 2nd China Verdi Singing Competition 2025, according to the following placement: the first classified will be admitted directly to the Final Concert, the second classified will be admitted to the Semi-final and the third, fourth and fifth classified will be admitted to the Qualifying round.

4.1 Selected candidates will be notified via email by November 3rd.

The list of admitted candidates will be published at vociverdiane.com and teatroregioparma.it.

4.2 To confirm participation, candidates must pay a **€ 100 registration fee** by November 10th via bank transfer to the account indicated in Art. 4.3, specifying in the reason for payment: Name and Surname – Iscrizione Fase Concorsuale Voci Verdiane 2025. Any possible bank commission fees are the candidate's responsibility. In order to be admissible, the candidate must send proof of payment of the fee to vociverdiane@teatroregioparma.it. The application fee will be refunded only in the event of cancellation of the Competition (Art. 9).

4.4 The Competition Phase will take place in Busseto according to the following calendar:

10-11 December 2025: Qualifying rounds and announcement of semi-finalists;

12 December 2025: Semi-final and announcement of the finalists;

13 December 2025: Vocal Coaching of the finalists and music rehearsals with pianist;

14 December 2025: Final-Concert open to the audience and announcement of the winners.

Candidates admitted to the Competition phase must be present on **10 December 2025, at Teatro Verdi di Busseto (PR)** at the time that will be communicated to the email address indicated in the registration form. The Competition Secretariat does not hold any responsibility if the candidate is not available at the indicated address or in the event of IT issues or other problems preventing such a communication. The candidate's absence will be considered as withdrawal.

Candidates requiring a visa must indicate this during the application process, providing the contact details of the Consulate or Embassy to which the Competition Secretariat will send a letter of invitation to and that the candidate may present to the institute

of reference. Candidates admitted to the Competition Phase must comply with the current laws and regulations in Italy regarding immigration for the entire period of their stay in Italy.

At the end of each of the Competition's sessions, the candidates admitted to the following stage will be announced and published online on vociverdiane.com and teatroregioparma.it.

The candidates admitted to the Competition Phase will perform divided by vocal register and will be called in alphabetical order, starting from the lowest register and the letter A of their surname. Such an order will be followed in all tests of the Competition.

Candidates must scrupulously respect the call times on all days of the Competition. Any impediments or delays must be promptly communicated to the Competition secretariat.

4.5 During the Competition Phase, candidates must present **4 arias by Giuseppe Verdi** chosen from those listed in the Appendix of these regulations, in the original language and tonality, with recitative and cabaletta where applicable (the repetition of the cabaletta is optional). Candidates must use their own scores, providing a copy to the accompanying Maestro.

4.6 The Jury of the Competition Phase is composed of:

The Jury will award three cash prizes to the top-three participants. At the beginning of the Competition, each member of the Jury will issue a declaration stating that they have no kinship, marriage, affinity and/or professional relationships (i.e. teacher-student, tutoring, artistic coaching, etc.) with any of the candidates. The members of the Jury who have or have had educational relationships with one or more candidates in the three years preceding the start of the Competition Phase will abstain from voting. Such an abstention will be recorded in the Competition minutes.

At any time, the Municipality of Busseto and Fondazione Teatro Regio may jointly call new members to join the Jury if, due to impediments, those already designated cannot be present.

Sessions are valid if the majority of members (including the President) are present.

The Honorary President of the Competition, the Mayor of Busseto, or his delegate may take part in any session of the Competition.

The Jury's decisions are final and binding. In the event of a tie, the President's vote prevails.

4.7 The program of the Competition Phase includes the following sessions:

Eliminatory round

10- 11 December 2025, Teatro Verdi di Busseto

Candidates will perform 2 arias among those presented: an aria of his choice and an aria of the Jury's choice. The Jury has the right to interrupt the rehearsal after the performance of the first piece. At the end of the Eliminatory round, the Jury will select a maximum of 20 semi-finalists who will advance to the next session.

Semi-final round

12 December 2025, Teatro Verdi di Busseto

Candidates will perform one or more arias chosen by the Jury from those indicated in the presented repertoire.

In both the Eliminatory and Semi-final rounds, the candidate will be accompanied by pianists selected by Fondazione Teatro Regio or may be accompanied, at their own expense, by an entrusted pianist by indicating such a decision during the application process.

At the end of the Semi-final, the Jury will select a **maximum of 10 finalists** who will be engaged in the subsequent Vocal Coaching and Rehearsal activities preceding the Final Concert.

The Jury will communicate to each finalist the aria to be performed in the Finale-Concert.

Vocal Coaching and piano rehearsals

13 December 2025, Teatro Verdi di Busseto

The vocal coaching and the piano rehearsals may be open to the audience and will not constitute an element of evaluation of the candidate.

Final-Concert

14 December 2025, Teatro Verdi di Busseto

Each finalist will perform their own aria.

At the end of the concert, the Jury will announce the top three classified as well as all the prizes and special mentions. The Final Concert will be open to the audience.

5. PRIZES

5.1 The Jury will award the following prizes:

1st Prize – € 5.000

2nd Prize – € 3.000

3rd Prize – € 2.000

The prizes are indicated as their gross amount (prior any legal withholding).

In case of a tie, the prize will be divided among the winners.

Artistic engagements: Teatro Regio di Parma commits to offering a role to at least one finalist, regardless of final ranking, in its 2026 season.

Other jury members representing opera houses may also offer engagements independently.

The Jury may choose not to award some or all prizes.

6. REPERTOIRE

For the Competition Phase, the candidate must present **4 opera arias by Giuseppe Verdi** among those indicated in such Regulations' Appendix. If one of the arias chosen by the candidate is not part of the said list, the Competition secretariat will ask for it to be replaced.

The arias must be performed in the original language and tonality and with recitative and cabaletta where provided (the repetition of the cabaletta is optional).

7. AUDIO AND VIDEO RECORDING

The candidate authorizes the Municipality of Busseto and Fondazione Teatro Regio di Parma to film or record audio or video, either entirely or partially, all phases of the Competition by using any current or future technologies including the Winners' concert, as well as any complementary recordings such as interviews. The candidate authorizes the Municipality of Busseto and Fondazione Teatro Regio di Parma Foundation to use the footage for any purpose and the recordings referred to in this article and to broadcast or stream them via any means, through either current or future technologies, including live television broadcasts, web networks (on one or more websites or social networks without limitation), in streamable and downloadable form, transferring any rights, including those of economic exploitation. Prior request and without making any further demands in such a regard, the candidate could take part in various initiatives, including those of a promotional nature, as well as in the creation of interviews and/or filmed documents relating to the Competition.

8. COMPETITION CANCELLATION

In the event of cancellation due to force majeure, all applications will be annulled and all registration fees will be refunded.
Such a decision is unappealable.

9. VALIDITY OF REGULATIONS

Such regulations are published in both Italian and English language. The Italian text has official and legal validity. In the event of disputes and for any dispute, the Court of Parma (Foro di Parma) will represent the the institution of reference.

Pursuant to art. 10, first paragraph, of Law 31.12.96 n.675, the personal data of the candidates will be collected by Teatro Regio di Parma for the purposes of this Competition.
